Largest contributor to the core product at Omnito - 5,954 of 12,483 commits over three years, across a Java backend on AWS Lambda and a React 18 / TypeScript client. Production AI is the deep end of that work: a multi-step assistant routing 13 skills, a RAG layer built by hand on pgvector, and an LLM-as-judge harness for a non-deterministic system. Led a team of 8 and rolled out Claude Code and Cursor across it, setting the review bar for AI-generated code.

- Largest contributor to the core product repository: 5,954 of 12,483 commits over three years, where the next contributor has 1,725, and the reviewer who merged three quarters of everything else the team shipped. Led a cross-functional team of 8 delivering a multi-tenant enterprise SaaS scheduling platform for 2,563 active tenants
- Shipped a production multi-step AI assistant: an LLM classifier routes intent to 13 skills, with context fetches issued speculatively in parallel so turn latency is the slowest fetch rather than their sum. Answers stream over WebSocket (LangChain, GPT-4o)
- Built its RAG layer by hand: OpenAI embeddings into a pgvector store implemented over JDBC, tenant isolation enforced by table rather than by query filter, fed by a headless-Chromium crawler on ECS Fargate with idempotent re-sync
- Built an LLM-as-judge evaluation harness into the ops console: it replays scripted question sets through the live assistant, generates follow-up turns and compares runs - regression testing for a non-deterministic system. Langfuse for tracing
- Rolled out Claude Code and Cursor across the team and set the review standard that holds AI-generated code to the same bar as anything else. Shipped the LLM meeting-notes pipeline: 2,000+ summaries per quarter at an 11% empty rate, tracked in PostHog
- Designed the backend: a single-dispatcher architecture routing 280 handlers against a 262-operation OpenAPI contract that generates both Java and TypeScript models, so frontend and backend cannot drift. ~107,000 lines of Java across 21 Lambdas, a 46-table DynamoDB model, an SNS-based async job framework, and SAML SSO over Cognito
- Built the multi-tenant access model: 13 permission domains with workspace scoping and signed, cached user contexts, over a three-level connector abstraction spanning 57 service classes - three CRMs (Salesforce, HubSpot, Microsoft Dynamics), two billing providers (Chargebee, Stripe) and five messaging channels

- Built and maintained the ~236,000-line React 18 / TypeScript client - 93 routes behind role-based guards, 48 Redux modules with redux-saga - and extended it onto Outlook add-ins and Chrome/Edge extensions; integrated 10+ platforms including Salesforce, HubSpot, Stripe and Microsoft 365
